We would like to remind our faithful of the following:

- 1 The annual dues are \$100.00/adult member
- 2 The Cemetery Fee Schedule is as follows:

*The Parish Dues and Cemetery Fees as stated above have been in effect since January 25, 2009.*

Please remember from your \$100.00 Parish Dues, that \$55.00 is set aside for the General Church Dues and \$25.00 for Western Diocese Dues. The remaining amount of \$20.00 is used to pay the 6% Fund of the General Church, Salaries, Utilities, and the needed expenses used to operate the Parish on a daily basis.

If you or family members are unable to fulfill our Parish Dues (obligation), please contact Father John so the appropriate exemption or hardship status can be applied. *Please note that the exemption and hardship status must be applied for on a yearly basis.*

As always, your stewardship to the Parish is not one of just your treasury, but also, your time and talents. To those who are able to donate more than just the minimum of the Parish Dues, we thank you for your generosity.
